

# Llwybr Foel Ispri

**Mae'n ddigon posib mai hwn yw llwybr hygyrch uchaf Cymru! Oddi yma cewch fwynhau golygfeydd trawiadol o ardal Dolgellau, Cader Idris ac aber y Fawddach. Byddwch yn barod i gael eich syfrdanu!**

**Pellter:** Tua 680metr (dwy ffordd)

**Gradd:** Hawdd/Mynediad i Bawb

**Dechrau/Diwedd:** Maes parcio bychan tua 2km i fyny'r ffordd o Taicynhaeaf ger Llanelltyd

**Cyfleusterau:** Maes parcio, meinciau

**Cyfeirnod Grid:** SH 698 200

**Côd post:** LL40 2TU

**Map perthnasol:** Arolwg Ordnans Explorer OL 23 Cadair Idris a Llyn Tegid

**Tirwedd:** Llwybr llydan a gwastad, addas i gadeiriau olwyn

O'r maes parcio bychan, cerddwch heibio tŷ'r Foel ac ewch drwy'r giât. Rydych yn awr yn cerdded ar hyd hen dramffordd gwaith aur Foel Ispri a fu'n gweithio rhwng tua 1835 a 1903. Bellach mae'r dramffordd wedi ei haddasu i fod yn lwybr hygyrch, hwylus i bawb.

Ewch ymlaen a mwynhewch yr olygfa dros foryd y Fawddach yn ymlwybro tua'r Bermo. Sylwch hefyd ar dollbont Llyn Penmaen gyda thafarn Siôr y 3<sup>ydd</sup> gerllaw.

Mewn ychydig, bydd y llwybr yn troi i'r chwith gan ddatgelu wyneb gogleddol Cader Idris, tref Dolgellau, ac yn serth, bron 800 troedfedd islaw, Afon Mawddach yn ymdroelli'n hamddenol tua'r môr. Mae'r dibyn yma yn rhoi i'r llwybr ei enw Saesneg sef "New Precipice Walk". Ymhen tua 300m daw'r llwybr hygyrch i ben ond mae llwybrau cyhoeddus yn arwain ymlaen i sawl cyfeiriad os am ymestyn y daith. Mae ein Taith y Mis ni'n troi'n ôl yma.



# Foel Ispri Path (New Precipice Walk)



**It is quite possible that this is Wales' highest accessible path! From here you can enjoy breathtaking views of Dolgellau, Cader Idris and the Mawddach estuary. Be prepared to be amazed!**

**Distance:** Around 680metres (both ways)

**Grade:** Easy/Access for All

**Start/Finish:** Small car park around 2km up the road from Taicyynhaef near Llanelltyd

**Facilities:** Car park, benches

**Grid reference:** SH 698 200

**Postcode:** LL40 2TU

**Relevant map:** Ordnance Survey Explorer OL 23 Cadair Idris & Llyn Tegid

**Terrain:** A wide and even path, suitable for wheelchairs

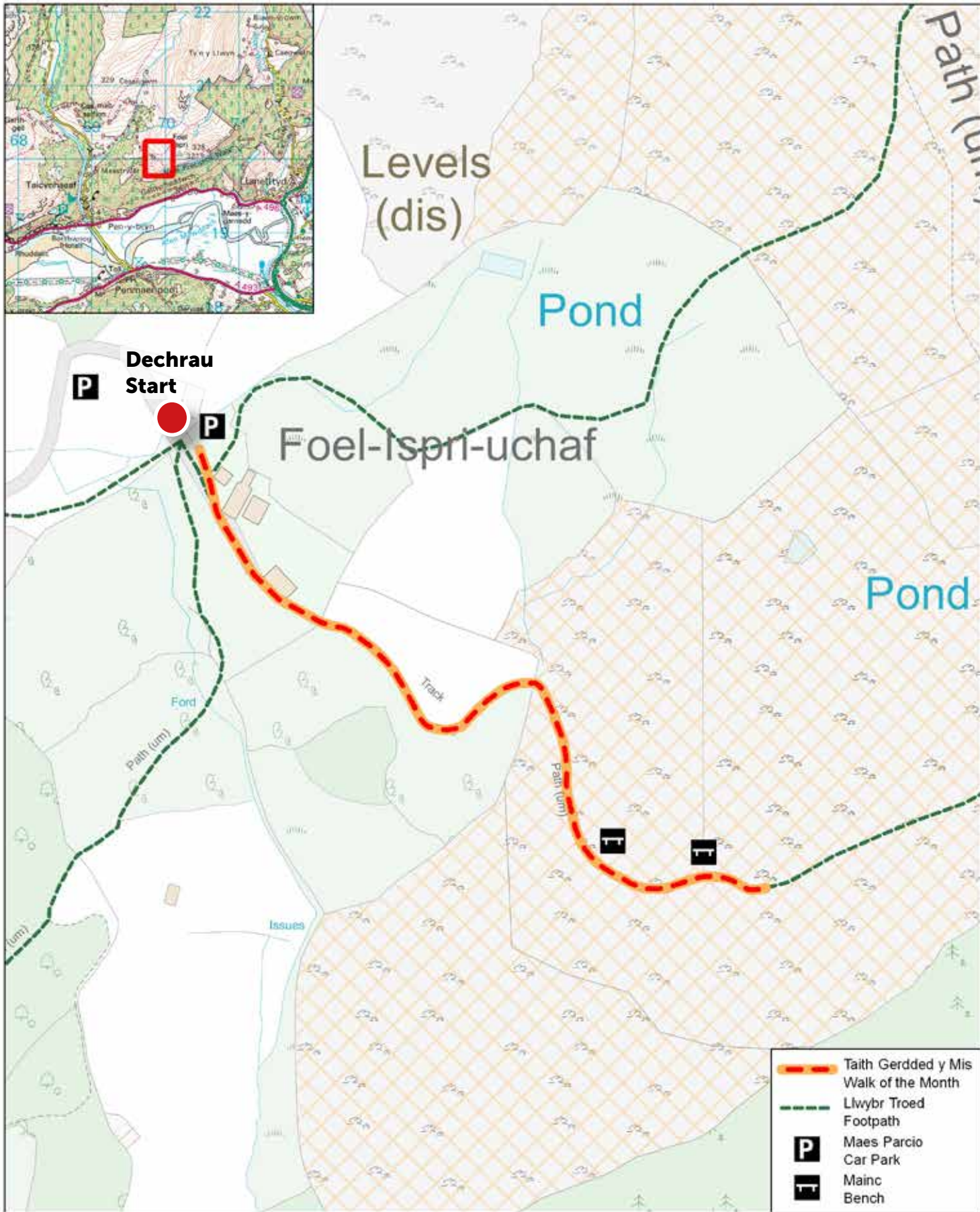
\* Please note that care should be taken when driving up to the car park as the road is steep and narrow with limited passing places.



**1** From the small car park, walk past the house and go through the gate. You are now walking along an old tramroad of the former Foel Ispri gold mine that was operational between around 1835 and 1903. The tramroad has now been transformed into an accessible route, convenient for all.


**2** Continue along the path and enjoy the view over the Mawddach estuary opening out towards Barmouth. Can you see the Penmaenpool tollbridge with the George III inn nearby?

**3** The path will shortly turn left, revealing the northern face of Cader Idris, the town of Dolgellau and a steep 800ft drop below, the Mawddach river slowly winding out to the sea. This drop gives this path its English name, 'New Precipice Walk'. In around 300 metres the accessible path will come to an end but the public footpath continues to a few directions if you wish to extend the walk. Our 'Walk of the Month' turns back here.
